LAKE SHORE POOL RULES 2021



Welcome, Pool Season 2021!

Below you will find a friendly reminder of the pool rules that are always expected to be followed in the pool area.

These rules are to ensure your safety and to keep Lake Shore beautiful!

Note: Lake Shore follows Chatham County code regarding the pool rules, which are posted at the pool for your viewing.

- 1. The pool may only be used during set pool hours.
- 2. All residents in good financial standing are welcome to use the pool. The Board of Directors reserves the right to check or challenge 'residency' of all entering the pool area.
- 3. All children should always have an adult in attendance when using the pool.
- 4. Children, three years old and younger, as well as any child not potty trained, must wear snug fitting plastic pants or a water-resistant swim diaper.
- 5. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a supervising adult. Minors are *NEVER* allowed to be in the pool area without constant parental oversight. Parents are responsible for the safety and conduct of their children.
- 6. Each home is allowed a maximum of 2 guests in the pool area and the resident *MUST* be in the pool area with all guests.
- 7. Non-residents or unapproved guests will be kindly asked to leave the property.
- 8. Persons suspected of being under alcohol and drug influences will be asked to leave the pool area.
- 9. Please, no running, jumping, screaming, or rough play.

10. Diving is not permitted in the pool!

- 11. Swimming should not be allowed during heavy rain or when thunder and lightning can be seen or heard.
- 12. Please do not bring glass articles in or around pool within the fenced area.
- 13. Please keep food, drink or wrappers ten feet (10') from the swimming pool or spa.
- 14. Please dispose of your trash properly.
- 15. Pets are not allowed in the pool area. If you have a registered service animal, it is <u>required</u> that you pick up after them. Registered service animals are allowed on the pool deck; however, <u>they are not allowed in the pool.</u>
- 16. Any games that involve throwing items are asked to be moved outside the pool gate to the common grass area surrounding the pool.
- 17. Please to do not use the pool if you are alone or unattended.
- 18. If there are any emergencies, trespassing or serious conduct issues in the pool area at any time, please contact the police by calling **911**. There is an emergency pool phone located in the pool area, for emergencies only.
